or the first time, all of Frederick Wiseman's 45 films are now available in digital format. 33 of these films, originally shot on 16mm and only available on film, have now been restored in 4K. Using original 16mm negatives and sound elements, the materials were personally reviewed and approved by Wiseman. This five year project - a collaboration between Zipporah Films, the Library of Congress, Harvard Film Archive, DuArt Labs and Goldcrest Post Production - will allow greater availability of Wiseman's work, removing barriers to allow access to wider audiences.

Beginning in the fall of 2024, comprehensive Wiseman retrospectives will screen at Centre Pompidou in Paris, American Cinematheque in Los Angeles, Film at Lincoln Center in New York, and other venues across the world.

At a sports boarding school, talented young boxer Camille narrowly survives a fatal accident, saved by his best friend Matteo. As pain forces him to step back, Camille starts questioning his dreams of greatness and his relation with the team. On the ring and in this men's world, there's no room for weakness.

Valéry Carnoy is a Belgian director who studied at the Institut National des Arts du Spectacle (Insas) in Brussels after studying intercultural psychology at the Université Libre de Bruxelles.

In 2018, his graduation short film My Planet won Best Film at the Tallinn Black Night Film Festival in the New Talent category. It received around twenty other awards from the press, jury and public while his second short film, Titan in 2021, a Franco-Belgian co-production was selected for a number of prestigious international festivals, including Clermont-Ferrand, Oberhausen, Busan and Palm Springs. The Foxes' Round (working title) is his first feature film and will be completed in 2025.

Bouchra, raised in a mausoleum dedicated to the saint Sidi Sardi, is confronted by a hostile imam who wants to turn her family home into a mosque. Her life is turned upside down when she meets Ahmed, a cameraman willing to help her make a film about the saint. This project plunges her into a captivating investigation, a saga through Tunisia and the 20th Century, that will shake her deeply-rooted beliefs. An initiation to love, myths and cinema.

Tunisian director Kaouther Ben Hania constantly explores the boundaries between fiction and documentary. Her latest film, Four Daughters, was nominated for the Best Documentary Academy Award® 2024 after being presented in Competition at the Cannes Film Festival. The film received numerous prestigious awards and was sold in over 40 territories. Her previous film The Man Who Sold His Skin was also nominated at the Academy Awards® for Best International Feature Film in 2021, representing Tunisia. Her film Beauty and The Dogs premiered at the Cannes Film Festival's Un Certain Regard section in 2017. All her other films have premiered at prestigious festivals including: Cannes, Venice, AFI, Los Angeles, Locarno, IDFA, Hot Docs Toronto. You Shall Not Make an Image will be her fifth film.

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
